KI BOIS Supportive Services for Veteran Families Program - Overview

SSVF is a housing first program that provides case management services to qualifying Veterans through:

- Supportive services to very low-income Veteran families in or transitioning to permanent housing
- Community outreach related to Veteran's needs and program goals
- Community and Veteran specific services and resources to benefit program participants

Eligible Participants

- Must be a member of a Veteran Family (Either a Veteran or spouse of a Veteran)
- Must be "very low-income" (less than 50% of the area median income)
- Must be homeless or in imminent risk of becoming homeless

Supportive Services

- Aims to improve very low-income Veterans families' housing stability through case management which may include linkage or referral to:
 - Home search and housing placement
 - Health Care Services
 - Personal Financial Planning Services
 - Transportation Services
 - Linkages to local, state, federal and tribal resources
 - Legal Services
 - Child Care Services
 - Housing Counseling Services

Temporary Financial Assistance

If a participant of the program qualifies, KI BOIS SSVF may be able to provide time-limited payments to third parties if these payments help Veteran families' stay in or acquire permanent housing on a sustainable basis. ie. Landlords, Utility Companies, Moving Companies, and Licensed Child Care Providers
