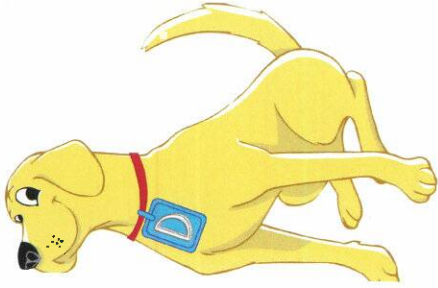


NOTICE

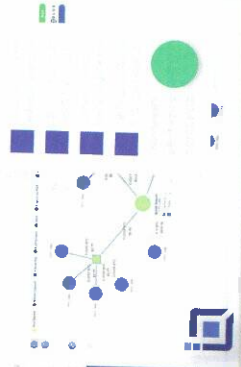

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The National Association of Drug Diversion Investigators (NADDI®) has made extensive efforts to feature the most current prescription drugs of abuse as identified by our law enforcement partners on the streets in this brochure. However, because of the vast array of generic drugs, it is impossible to display all pill types and logos for each chemical substance. Law enforcement officers, and others who wish to identify prescription drugs not included in this brochure, should contact the **National Poison Control Hotline at 1-800-222-1222**. By calling this number, you will be automatically connected to the drug and poison information center nearest you, who will assist in identifying the pill.

★ WARNING ★

In the last decade, law enforcement has encountered a dramatic increase in numerous new novel psychoactive substances (NPS), including NPS opioids, NPS stimulants, and NPS benzodiazepines that have been manufactured by clandestine labs to resemble legitimately manufactured pharmaceutical products. The red star symbol has been placed next to substances (on the reverse side of this brochure) that have been forensically identified as counterfeits that have caused overdose/death events.

While all of these counterfeit pharmaceutical products look like legitimately manufactured products, they have been found to contain structural derivatives of illicit substances which continue to pose great challenges for forensic scientists, clinicians, and public health and safety personnel. NPS opioids have been implicated in an increasing number of emergency room admissions, death investigations, and mass intoxication events, and often appear in combination with other illicit opioids (e.g. fentanyl, heroin).

Even limited exposure to an NPS derivative product can pose a significant health & safety threat to law enforcement personnel, and other first responders. Individuals who encounter any derivative substances through illegal use, routine law enforcement, or emergency life-saving activities are at **HIGH RISK OF EXPOSURE**. Since all NPS substances are made to be ingested orally, or inhaled through the nose, exposure to **any substance suspected to contain any derivative NPS should be treated with extreme caution as exposure to a small amount can lead to significant health-related complications, respiratory depression, or death.**






