The Certified Peer Recovery Support Specialist (PRSS) fulfills a unique role in the support of and recovery from mental health issues and substance use disorders. A PRSS is a person in recovery from a mental health diagnosis and/or substance use disorder, who has been trained to work with others on their individual road to recovery. This training incorporates the PRSS's recovery experience as a means of inspiring hope in those they serve, as well as providing a positive role model to others. They know the journey to recovery is real and attainable because they have travelled the path themselves.


OKShine: Health Information Exchange



Did you know Oklahoma has a statewide health information exchange (HIE)? Did you know that if you are a licensed health care provider, including SUD or behavioral health providers, that you are eligible to sign up for the HIE?

The HIE allows health information to flow seamlessly to and from providers in Oklahoma which allows us to enhance health care delivery. It creates the connection to allow appropriate and secure access to clinical data for safe, more timely, efficient, effective, equitable, patient-centered care. SUD and behavioral health providers may find the HIE particularly useful to gain a "whole picture" of a patient's health to aid in the reduction of risk and adverse side effects.

Want to sign up for the state HIE, OKSHINE? Follow this 3 step process:

- Apply to participate in Oklahoma's Health Information Exchange and obtain an order form.
- Complete an application through the office of the state coordinator to recieve assistance with one-time connection fee costs. Subscription fees are not included.
- Recieve approval from the office of the state coordinator.
